NOTES FOR INVITATION FOR BID:

- Sealed bids should be submitted in duplicate at the 2nd Floor, Division of Highways Building Room 201, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913, no later than 2:00 P.M., on the date specified above. At this time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud to the public.
- Contract time is per the calendar days after the issuance of Notice to Proceed as specified above. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 15% of the total bid amount. Accepted form of bid security may be bid bond, certified check or cashier's check payable to the Treasurer of Guam.
- Bid documents can be obtained at no cost at the 2nd Floor, Division of Highways Building Room 201, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913.** All bidders who secured the corresponding bid documents will be officially listed in the Government's Distribution Record as prospective bidders for these construction projects. At the DPW's discretion, the DPW may provide the documentation electronically via CD. Log onto the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) website at www.wfl.fha.dot.gov/design/specs/fp03.htm to obtain a copy of the "Standard Specifications for Construction of Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects, FP-03". - The sureties of all bonds must be on the approved listing by the Government of Guam and the United States Department of Treasury (with exception for Project No.

GU-PAG-0011(004), which only United States Department of Treasury listed sureties are accepted) listed as "Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds and Acceptable Reassuring Companies". The penal amount of the bond shall not exceed the surety's underwriting limit as stated in the Department of Treasury listing. A notarized true copy of Certificate of Authority is also required.

Pre-bid conferences will be held on the dates specified above, at 9:00 A.M., at the 2nd Floor, Conference Room 201, Division of Highways Building, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913. All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend. Items discussed during pre-bid conferences will be made part of the contract document.
