ROUTE 1, ASAN SOUTH MARINE CORPS DRIVE DEAD MAN'S CURVE

MAY TO JULY 2025



As part of the Island-Wide Safety Improvements Project—funded by the Federal Highway Administration and including striping along Route 1 from the Route 1/6 intersection to the Route 1/11 intersection - the Department of Public Works (DPW) will enhance safety along Dead Man's Curve in Asan.

Safety enhancements specific to Dead Man's Curve are expected to begin in May and will include the installation of rumble stripes, optical speed bars, narrowed travel lanes, and wider edge pavement markings along the 2,200-foot stretch.
