TRAFFIC NOTICE NEW STOP SIGN INSTALLATION

EFFECTIVE SATURDAY, JULY 23, 2022

Route 15/Route 26
Macheche Road - Dededo

Improvements at the intersections of **Route 15/Route 26** and **Route 15/Route 29/Gayinero Drive** are underway. Please take notice that new stop signs will be installed along Route 15 at these intersections as a safety measure. The new All-Way Stop (4-Way Stop Sign) traffic pattern will take effect on **Saturday, July 23, 2022**.

Currently, motorists travel along Route 15 without stopping. The new configuration will include new stop signs on the north and southbound lanes of Route 15 at these intersections.

Route 15/Route 29
Gayinero Drive - Yigo

This new condition along Route 15 will be marked by new **"STOP"** signs, new pavement markings, and new **"STOP AHEAD"** signs. Additionally, there will be warning signs temporarily installed along Route 15 one week prior to alert motorists approaching the intersection of the new stop condition.

The Department of Public Works asks motorists to use caution and to follow All-Way Stop(4-Way Stop) rules when approaching these intersections. Thank you for taking notice of and obeying traffic rules at these new stop signs.
